5 QUICK CHECKS TO

KEEP YOUR PLAYGROUND SAFE, COMPLIANT & READY TO PLAY





1. DEPTH CONSISTENCY

Still deep enough in all impact zones?

Surfacing should be 300mm deep — erosion and compaction can reduce this fast, especially under swings and slides.



2. SURFACE COMPACTION

Is it soft and springy — or hard-packed?

Over time, impact zones can compact, losing their shock-absorbing ability. Test it with a heel press.



3. MOISTURE DRAINAGE

Does water drain quickly after rain?

Pooling or lingering moisture signals poor drainage. This shortens lifespan and increases the slip risk.



4. CONTAMINATION OR DEGRADATION

Any weeds, mould, sharp debris or breakdown dust?

These signs mean your surface is starting to degrade — and might not meet safety standards.



5. VISUAL COVERAGE & EVENNESS

Are there bare patches or exposed underlay?

Patchy coverage under high-use areas can fail fall-height rules. Even wear = safer play.
